Instructions for Submission

Before starting your submission, please ensure you have the following information prepared:

1. Author and Co-authors' Details

- Full first and family name(s).
- Affiliation information: department, institution/hospital, city, country.

2. Presenting Author Contact Information

- Email address.
- Phone number.

3. Abstract Title

- Limited to 25 words.
- Must be in UPPER CASE.

4. Abstract Text

- Limited to 250 words.

5. For the published paper on high impact factor

Provide DOI /direct link of the paper in the accepting journal

Ensure all the required information is prepared and formatted correctly before submission. This will facilitate a smooth and efficient review process. Thank you for your contribution to the field of pediatric infectious diseases.
